CCTV Surveillance

Iris has installed CCTV cameras at various locations in its buildings to ensure the safety of clients, visitors, and employees; to prevent, detect or investigate incidents involving individuals or property; and to avoid disturbances. The cameras provide a general overview of a given area. Identifying individuals is not the objective, unless a security incident occurs.

The cameras are installed at building entrances, parking areas, and inside the buildings, in such a way that only people accessing the premises are recorded. No audio (voice or sound) is captured.

The processing of personal data through CCTV surveillance is done in accordance with the Belgian law of 21 March 2007 regulating the installation and use of surveillance cameras, as well as any other applicable privacy and data protection legislation.

The legal basis for this processing is Iris's legitimate interest in ensuring the security of its buildings and people. Camera usage is clearly signposted with the legally required pictograms, including Iris's contact information.

Footage is retained for a maximum of one month, unless it is required as evidence in the context of an investigation or legal proceedings.

Access to footage is strictly limited to authorized Iris personnel and is protected by password. Footage may only be shared with law enforcement authorities.
